BY-LAW NUMBER 63-75

A By-law to amend By-law Number 39-74, to provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways in the City of Brampton.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 39-74, being a By-law to provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways in the City of Brampton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

- 1) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 39-74 be amended by the deletion therefrom of the following under the appropriate columns thereof.

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Facing Traffic</u>
McMurchy Avenue and Edwin Drive	Westbound on Edwin Drive


- 2) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 39-74 be amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof.


<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Facing Traffic</u>
McMurchy Avenue and Harold Street	Northbound on McMurchy Avenue
McMurchy Avenue and Harold Street	Southbound on McMurchy Avenue
McMurchy Avenue and Harold Street	Westbound on Harold Street
McMurchy Avenue and Harold Street	Eastbound on Harold Street
McMurchy Avenue and Frederick Street	Northbound on McMurchy Avenue

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Facing Traffic</u>
McMurchy Avenue and Frederick Street	Southbound on McMurchy Avenue
McMurchy Avenue and Frederick Street	Westbound on Frederick Street

- 3) The provisions of this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of The Corporation of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
