The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 33-79, as amended, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic on City of Brampton highways, is further amended as follows:
 - i) Part 1, section (1) is amended by deleting the definition of "IDENTIFYING MARKER" and substituting the following therefor:

"IDENTIFYING MARKER" means a marker or licence plate consisting of the international symbol for the physically handicapped person issued in connection with a permit or by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

ii) Part 2, section (3) is amended by adding subsection VIII)
as follows:

For the purposes of this by-law, where a person has attached to the motor vehicle a licence plate bearing the international symbol for the physically handicapped person, issued by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications, such plate shall be deemed to be an approved and properly displayed identifying marker.


- iii) Subsection (4) and (5) of Part 6, as added by By-law 316-81 are repealed.
- iv) Part 6 is amended by adding sections (6) and (7) as follows:
 - (6) Notwithstanding section (1) of this Part, any person who contravenes paragraphs II, III or IV of section (3) of Part 2 is guilty of an offence, and upon conviction shall be subject to a penalty of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).

(7) Notwithstanding section (1) of this Part, any person who contravenes paragraph VII of section (3) of Part 2 is guilty of an offence, and upon conviction shall be subject to a penalty of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first offence and not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each subsequent offence.
