To authorize an agreement with the
Brampton and Area Community Foundation
for the George Hitchcock Bursary

WHEREAS funds have been donated by the public to establish an endowment fund for fire and life safety education, since the passing of Firefighter George Hitchcock, former Division Chief, Fire and Life Safety Education;

AND WHEREAS on January 25, 2012 by Resolution C005-2012, Brampton City Council authorized staff to negotiate and finalize an agreement with the Brampton and Area Community Foundation for the creation of a bursary for the distribution of charitable funds previously donated previously to the City and received in the future in the name of George Hitchcock;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents required, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and content approved by the Commissioner of Community Services, for the Brampton and Area Community Foundation to create and maintain the George Hitchcock Bursary, to be awarded annually to a Brampton student pursuing a career in the Fire Service.
