Number 66-83

To alter part of Braemar
Drive

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to alter part of Braemar Drive by removing therefrom the existing traffic control island for the purpose of permitting two-way traffic movements at the location of this island;


AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council for said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons who claim that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. That part of Braemar Drive be altered by removing therefrom the existing traffic control island situate thereon immediately north of the intersection of Braemar Drive and Brookland Drive for the purpose of permitting two-way traffic movements at the location of this island.
2. The Commissioner of Public Works shall remove or cause to be removed the aforesaid traffic control island and he is hereby authorized to do all things necessary in his opinion to complete the removal and restore Braemar Drive for two-way traffic movements at the location of this island.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in
Open Council this 7th day of MARCH, 1983.
