To amend By-law 56-83, as amended, in respect of parking of large motor vehicles

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - a) by deleting therefrom in Section 5 (DEFINITIONS), the definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE; and
  - b) by adding to Section 5 the following definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE:

"LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE shall mean any motor vehicle having a vehicle weight greater than 2500 kilograms or an overall height greater than 2.3 metres, or both".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 23rd day of April , 1990.
