To amend By-law 151-88, as amended,
in respect of parking of large
motor vehicles


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

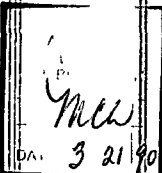
1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - a) by deleting therefrom in Section 5 (DEFINITIONS), the definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE; and
 - b) by adding to Section 5 the following definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE:

"LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE shall mean any motor vehicle having a vehicle weight greater than 2500 kilograms or an overall height greater than 2.3 metres, or both".
2. By-law 232-88 is hereby repealed.

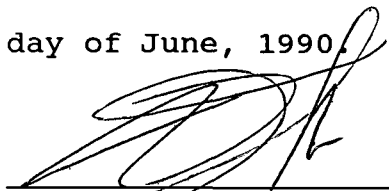
