

Registered Plan M-142


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume certain streets and lands shown on Registered Plan M-142 as public highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The land described in Schedule A to this by-law be and the same is hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 71-82

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the
Regional Municipality of Peel, being:

FIRSTLY: The whole of the part of Locustwood Court shown on
a Plan of Subdivision registered in the Land Registry
Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43)
as M-142;

SECONDLY: The whole of Blocks B and C, according to the said
registered plan M-99.
(to be part of Vodden Street)

THIRDLY: The whole of Blocks D and E, according to the said
registered plan M-99.
(to be part of Locustwood Court)
