Being	a	By-Law	to	make	it	lawful	for	

any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day.

WHEREAS the Kinsmen Club of Brampton proposes to hold part of its Springtime Carnival on Sunday the 25th day of April, 1982.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 259, is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton in respect of the activities to be conducted by the Kinsmen Club of Brampton hereinafter specified, namely, the operation of carnival rides and a midway, including shows, riding devices, and concessions not otherwise prohibited by law; all of which activities are to take place at the Bramalea City Centre, 1 Peel Centre Drive, in conjuction with the Kinsmen Springtime Carnival.
- 2. The said activities specified in paragraph 1 shall be limited to the period between on and six o'clock in the afternoon of Sunday, the 25th day of April, 1982, but nothing in this paragraph shall limit the time during which said club may conduct any aspect of its carnival which would not otherwise be unlawful under the Lord's Day Act (Canada).
- 2. All activities permitted by this By-Law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.
