I/WE further agree that, if the Tender is accepted by the City, we will execute whatever additional work may be required at the Unit Prices shown herein, in strict conformity and in all respects with the requirements of this Tender, Specifications, General Conditions and Form of Agreement hereto annexed or to be annexed hereto.

I/WE also agree that deductions from the said contract, if any, shall be made at the unit prices shown in the Schedule of Quantities and Unit Prices as herein contained.

I/WE agree that this offer is to continue open to acceptance until the formal contract is executed by the successful Tenderer for the said work or until two (2) months after the Tender closing date whichever event first occurs, and that the City may at any time within that period and without notice accept this Tender whether any other Tender had been previously accepted or not.

I/WE agree that if we withdraw this Tender after closing and before the Council of the said City shall have considered the Tenders and awarded the Contract in respect thereof, during the time that this Tender is open to acceptance as set out above in this Tender Form the amount of the deposit accompanying this Tender shall be forfeited to the City.

I/WE agree that the awarding of the Contract based on this Tender by the Council of the said City shall be an acceptance of this Tender.

If this Tender is accepted I/WE agree to furnish the required Contract Bond, in the form attached hereto, Insurance Certificate and Workmen's Compensation Board Letter, and properly sign the Contract Documents in triplicate within seven (7) days after being notified so to do. In the event of default or failure on our part so to do, I/WE agree that the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be at liberty to retain the money deposited by ME/US to the use of the City and to accept the next lowest or any Tender or to advertise for new Tenders, or to carry out the works in any other way they deem best and I/WE also agree to pay to the said City the difference between this Tender and any greater sum which the City may expend or incur by reason of such default or failure, or by reason of such acting, as aforesaid, on their part, including the cost of any advertisement for new Tenders; and to indemnify and save harmless the said City and their Officers from all loss, damage, cost, charges, and expense which they may suffer or be put to by reason of any such default or failure on MY/OUR part.
