



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 76-95

To further amend By-law 141-92
(the Cemetery By-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that increased operating costs require an increase in the rates charged for various services relating to the operation of cemeteries owned by the City of Brampton. Council has also determined that additional cemeteries which were acquired in 1994 be governed by By-law 141-92 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Schedule A to By-law 141-92 as amended is hereby amended by adding the following:
 20. St. Mary's (Tullamore) Cemetery - Part of Lot 17, Concession 6 E.H.S., west side of Airport Road south of Mayfield Road.
 21. St. John's (Castlemore) Cemetery - Part of Lot 9, Concession 9 Northern Division, west side of The Gore Road south of Castlemore Road.
 22. St. John's (Snelgrove) Cemetery - part of Lot 19, Plan CH-8, east side of Highway 10 (Hurontario Street) south of Mayfield Road.
2. Schedule B to By-law 141-92 as amended is hereby deleted and replaced by Schedule A to this By-law.

Monument Foundations

All foundations are 5 feet deep.
Installation charges are based on the number of square feet of surface area of the foundation at ground level.
