Number 777-82
To establish certain lands as parts of public highways

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to establish certain lands as parts of public highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The lands owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton, and described in Schedule A hereto attached, be and the same are hereby established as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.
- 2. By-law 70-82 is hereby repealed.
