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To authorize the encroachment of part of a building, porch steps and walkway located at 17 Moore Street upon part of Moore Street

WHEREAS paragraph 101 of Section 210 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> (R.S.O 1980, chapter 302, as amended) permits the Council of a local municipality to pass a by-law for allowing any person owning any building that by inadvertence has been partially erected upon any highway to maintain and use such erection thereon;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The owners of the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto are hereby given permission to maintain and use part of the building, concrete porch, concrete steps and walk erected on the part of Moore Street on Registered Plan BR-25 designated as Part 2 on Reference Plan 43R-1882, but only until the existing building is demolished or removed from the lands described in Schedule "A".
- 2. The owner shall pay to The Corporation of the City of Brampton, on the 14th day of May, 1990, the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00), for the privilege granted by this bylaw.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of May, 1990.
