To authorize the sale of part of the road allowance between Lots 10 and 11, Concession 5 East of Hurontario Street

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 38-80 which stopped up and closed part of the road allowance between Lots 10 and 11, Concession 5 East of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 3 and 4 on Plan 43R-18949, as part of the realignment of Bovaird Drive.

Bovaird Drive is now part of the Regional road system and the Regional Municipality of Peel, the abutting owner, has requested a conveyance of the said lands.

Notice of Council's intention to pass this by-law has been advertised once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian as required by Section 300 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45 as amended.

Council has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared as surplus to the requirements of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
- The sale of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law to the Regional Municipality of Peel for the price of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to complete the sale transaction described in section 2.
- 4. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B forms part of this by-law.
