A by-law respecting smoking in the Council Chamber

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. In this by-law,
 - 1.1 "City" means the City of Brampton.
 - 1.2 "smoke" or "smoking" includes the carrying of a
 lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other
 lighted smoking equipment.
 - "Council Chamber" means the City Council Chamber situate in the municipal building known as
 150 Central Park Drive, Brampton.
 - 1.4 "smoking area" means that part of the Council
 Chamber in which the rear or back two rows of
 public seats and the press tables are situate.
- No person shall smoke in the Council Chamber except in the smoking area.
- 3. The City shall ensure that a sufficient number of signs indicating the smoking prohibition and regulation set out in section 2 shall be prominently displayed so as to be clearly visible from all parts of the Council Chamber.

- 4. This by-law shall be administered and enforced by the Commissioner of Buildings and By-law Enforcement and such other persons who may from time to time be appointed by by-law or by resolution of Council.
- 5. Every person who smokes in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a penalty of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) exclusive of costs.
