BY-LAW

Number 84-86

To change the name
of MacVean Drive

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of MacVean Drive;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Brampton Guardian and the Brampton Times, two newspapers having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The name of the street known as "MacVean Drive ", which is described in Schedule A attached hereto, is changed to "McVean Drive".
2. By-law number 1055 of the former Township of Toronto Gore is hereby repealed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of April , 1986.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 84-86

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Toronto Gore, County of Peel) being the road allowance between Concessions 8 and 9, Northern Division, from the northerly limit of Highway Number 7 to the southerly limit of No. 17 Sideroad (now known as Mayfield Road).
