# BY-LAW

**Number** 87-92

To amend By-law 318-80  
(the Cemetery By-law)

---

WHEREAS By-law 318-80 was passed on the 15th day of December, 1980, to provide for the maintenance, management, regulation and control of certain cemeteries within the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS Schedules B and C to By-law 318-80 provide for rates for cemetery charges;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate to revise the rates for cemetery charges;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 318-80, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting therefrom Schedule B and substituting therefor Schedule A to this by-law.
2. That By-law 318-80, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting therefrom Schedule C and substituting therefor Schedule B to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of May, 1992.
