## **BY-LAW**

A By-law to Repeal By-law 132-2000 and to appoint new License Issuers

Whereas By-law 1-2002 requires that persons seeking a business license apply to a License Issuer:

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 132-2000 is repealed.
- 2. The

Director of Enforcement and By-law Services, Legal Services; and Supervisor, Licensing Enforcement, Legal Services

are appointed License Issuers for:

licenses issued to persons taking out a license under Sections 2(2), 2(3), 2(11), 2(12), 2(14), 2(15), or 2(16) of By-law 1-2002.

3. The

Manager of Vital Statistics and Licensing Administration, Council and Administrative Services, Management and Administrative Services

is appointed License Issuer for:

licenses issued to persons taking out a license under Sections 2(1), 2(4), 2(5), 2(6), 2(7), 2(8), 2(9), 2(10), 2(12), 2(13), 2(17), 2(18), 2(19), 2(20), 2(21), 2(22), 2(23), 2(24), 2(25), 2(26), 2(27), 2(28), 2(29), 2(30), 2(31), 2(32), or 2(33) of By-law 1-2002.

4. The

Sign Coordinator, Building Division, Planning, Design and Development

is appointed License Issuer for:

licenses issued to persons taking out a license under Sections 2(27) of By-law 1-2002.

5. If a job title referred to in this by-law changes, an appointment will continue to be valid and will apply to the person holding the successor job title.
