To accept and assume as public highways certain lands shown on Registered Plan M-296

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume certain lands shown on Registered Plan M-296 as public highways;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described in Schedule A to this by-law are established as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 91-85

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, being

- FIRSTLY: the part of Charolais Boulevard as shown on a plan of subdivision registered in Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as number M-296;
- SECONDLY: the part of Moffatt Avenue (the name of which was changed to Torrance Woods by By-law 112-80, a certified copy of which was received for registration in said Land Registry Office on May 1, 1980 as Instrument Number 265986) as shown on said Registered Plan M-296;
- THIRDLY: the whole of Abelard Avenue as shown on said Registered Plan M-296;
- FOURTHLY: the whole of Dafoe Crescent as shown on said Registered Plan M-296; and
- FIFTHLY: the part of Pearson Road as shown on said Registered Plan M-296.
