To amend the Zoning By-law 2004 (By-law 270-2004) as amended

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. The Zoning By-law 2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by adding the word "zoned" after the words "Industrially or Commercially" in the first paragraph of Section 6.29.
 - (2) by deleting the words "or auxiliary group home" in Section 10.14(b).
 - (3) by changing the reference to "24.1" in Section 2560 to "31.3".


DECLARATION
