BY-LAW

Number 93-89

To authorize the acquisition
of certain lands (George Street
Transit Terminal)

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to construct an underground parking garage as part of the George Street transit terminal project.

AND WHEREAS the design of the ramp leading from George Street requires the acquisition of additional lands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The acquisition from Francesco Renna and Antonietta Renna of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law at a purchase price not to exceed \$80,000.00 is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor necessary to effect the acquisition.
3. This by-law shall come into force upon the approval by the Ontario Municipal Board of the construction and financing of the George Street transit terminal and underground parking garage.

SCHEDULE A to By-law 93-89

The land situated in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel), being composed of part of Lots 80 and 81, Block 12, Plan BR-4, more particularly described as follows:

PREMISING that the northerly limit of Nelson Street West has an astronomic bearing of North 38 degrees 09 minutes 30 seconds East and relating all bearings quoted herein thereto;

COMMENCING at the intersection of the Northwest limit of Nelson Street West and the Northeast limit of George Street North where an iron bar has been planted, being the southerly angle of the said Lot 80;

THENCE North 44 degrees 17 minutes 50 seconds West along the Northeast limit of George Street North, 116.0 feet to an iron bar planted, being the point of commencement;

THENCE North 40 degrees 31 minutes 40 seconds East, 92.78 feet to an iron bar planted;

THENCE South 45 degrees 50 minutes 30 seconds East, 9.84 feet to a point;

THENCE South 40 degrees 31 minutes 40 seconds West, 92.78 feet to a point in the Northeast limit of George Street North;

THENCE North 44 degrees 17 minutes 50 seconds East along the Northeast limit of George Street North, 9.84 feet to the point of commencement.
