# BY-LAW

Number 94-85

To provide for the establishment  
and operation of an elderly persons  
centre known as the Centennial Recreation  
and Senior Citizens Centre

WHEREAS section 3 of the Elderly Persons Centres Act provides that the council of a municipality may by by-law approved by the Minister of Community and Social Services provide for the establishment and operation of elderly persons centres;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to establish and operate such a centre;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands and premises described as parts of Lots 9, 10 and 13 on Plan BR-21 and municipally known as 80 Mary Street in Brampton, and the buildings and facilities thereon, including the community hall and the meeting and craft rooms, are hereby established as a centre, as defined in section 1(c) of the Elderly Persons Centres Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.131, as amended), in accordance with section 3 of the Elderly Persons Centres Act.
2. The elderly persons centre established by section 1 of this by-law shall be operated by the City of Brampton.
3. The elderly persons centre established by section 1 of this by-law shall be known as the "CENTENNIAL RECREATION AND SENIOR CITIZENS CENTRE".
