1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Creditview Road	60	A point 350 metres north of Queen Street West and Queen Street West	Anytime

2. Section (1), subsections (1), (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this by-law shall not come into force until approved by the council of the Regional Municipality of Peel.
