The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute the following documents between The Corporation of the City of Brampton and Brampton Sports Centre Inc. for the 6000 Seat Entertainment/Sports Complex referred to in Request for Proposal No. RFP96-003:
 - 1.1 the Master Development Agreement
 - 1.2 the Ground Lease
 - 1.3 the Insurance Trust Agreement
 - 1.4 the Project Financing Commitment
 - 1.5 the Loan and Priorities Agreement
 - 1.6 the Facilities Provision Agreement.
- 2. The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute notices of fulfillment, waiver, or extension of the conditions set out in Sections 5.1 and 5.3 of the Master Development Agreement in accordance with instructions given by the 6000 Seat Arena Committee.
- 3. The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute all agreements, transfers, assignments, certificates, documents, and instruments as may be required or which are necessary or desirable to permit the closing of the transactions pursuant to the Master Development Agreement to be concluded, and to implement and give full force and effect to the terms, conditions, and restrictions contemplated by all of the documents referred to in paragraph 1 of this by-law.

4. All of the documents referred to in paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of this bylaw shall be approved by the Commissioner of Community Services and the Commissioner of Legal Services and City Solicitor before they are executed by the Mayor and the Clerk.
