BY-LAW

> To Change the Name of Edenbrook Hill Road

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it necessary to change the name of Edenbrook Hill Road;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in The Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The name of Edenbrook Hill Road dedicated on Registered Plan 43M-1439 is changed to Edenbrook Hill Drive.
- 2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule "A" hereto shall form part of this by-law.
