To declare surplus and authorize the sale of part of Rosalea Park and to authorize the acquisition of the McMurchy Avenue YMCA property

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared surplus and the transfer of the said lands to the YMCA of Greater Toronto at a price of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
- 2. The purchase of the lands and premises described as part of the West half of Lot 2, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street, designated as Parts 1, 2 and 4 on Plan 43R-340, from the YMCA of Greater Toronto at a price of \$1,800,000.00 is hereby authorized.
- 3, The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the land transactions authorized by this by-law.
