


A By-law to prohibit the obstructing, encumbering or fouling of highways.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby enacts as follows:

1. No person shall throw, place, deposit or permit to be blown or escape from premises occupied by him or dropped or blown from a vehicle owned or operated by him any dirt, filth, glass, paper, hand-bills, garbage, ashes, rubbish, the carcass of any animal, or any other refuse or waste material on any highway in the City of Brampton. No person shall permit any dog owned by him to foul any public highway or part thereof and in the event that a dog does foul a public highway or part thereof the owner shall be responsible for clearing away the dog's foulings and restoring the public highway or part thereof to its previous condition.
2. Any person or persons who contravenes the provisions of this By-law upon Summary Conviction shall pay a penalty not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), exclusive of costs.
