AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93- 16  
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE  
CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 28: Sandringham-Wellington to include Amendment Number 247 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

2.0 Location:

The lands subject to this amendment are those lands located within Sub-Area 4 of Secondary Plan Area Number 28 (The Sandringham-Wellington Secondary Plan) which are subject to the provisions set out in Chapter 28 of PART IV: SECONDARY PLANS of the 1984 Official Plan.

More specifically, the subject location is bounded by the proposed extension of Sandalwood Parkway to the north, Bramalea Road to the west, Torbram Road to the east and Bovaird Drive to the south.

3.0 Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto:

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- (1) by adding to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 28: Sandringham-Wellington, as set out in PART II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number 247 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.
