# BY-LAW

Number 110-76

Being a By-law to amend By-law 22-75

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton have enacted By-law 22-75 to provide for the management, control, regulations, maintenance and usage of all parklands and properties owned or leased by the City of Brampton for Park or Recreation purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council deem it expedient to amend the aforementioned By-law 22-75;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That Clause 3(e) be deleted and the following substituted therefor:

3(e) To lead, carry or otherwise take any animal upon or into City parkland with the exception of household pets who must be kept under control, provided that dogs must be led by a leash or chain being not more than six feet long. When leading a dog by a leash or chain as required, to not clean up and remove the dogs' droppings.

To allow dogs either attended or unattended to foul any public parks, squares or ground.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of April, 1976.
