To authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$142,000.00 for the purchase of fire equipment.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the purchase of fire equipment;

AND WHEREAS the approval from the Ontario Municipal Board has been granted on the 10th day of April, 1985, Board File Number E 850341.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

 The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the purchase of fire equipment set out in Schedule "A" to this by-law at a total estimated cost of \$142,000.00.

The Mayor and Treasurer are hereby authorized to borrow from time to time, in the name of and on behalf of the City, from the Royal Bank of Canada at 1 Main Street North in Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate of \$142,000.00 for the equipment set out in Schedule "A" to this by-law, and to give to the Royal Bank of Canada on behalf of the City, promissory notes signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer under the corporate seal for the money so borrowed, containing terms and conditions satisfactory to the Treasurer.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 6th day of May, 1985.
