
The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

- (1) By changing, on Sheet 23 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from: -  
AGRICULTURAL (A) to SINGLE DETACHED D - SECTION 1180  
(RID - SECTION 1180), RESIDENTIAL SINGLE DETACHED C -  
SECTION 1229 (RIC - SECTION 1229), RESIDENTIAL SINGLE  
DETACHED C - SECTION 1230 (RIC - SECTION 1230),  
RESIDENTIAL SINGLE DETACHED C - SECTION 1231 (RIC -  
SECTION 1231), RESIDENTIAL SINGLE DETACHED D - SECTION  
1232 (RID - SECTION 1232), and FLOODPLAIN (F).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN  
COUNCIL, this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2004.



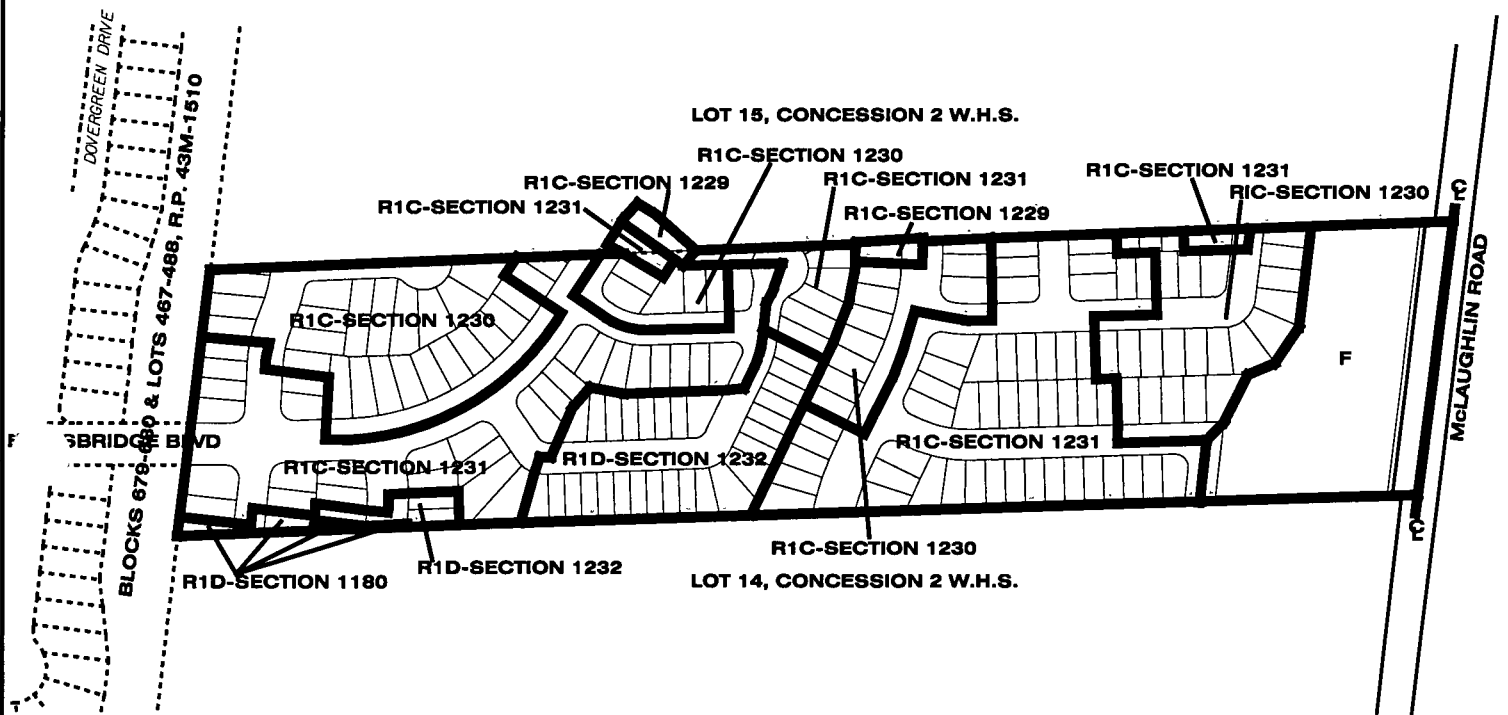
