



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 118-83

Being a By-law to make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day.

WHEREAS the Bramalea Jaycees propose to hold part of their Carnival on Sunday, the 8th day of May, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, P.S.O., 1970, Chapter 259, is hereby declared to apply in the City of Brampton in respect of the activities to be conducted by the Bramalea Jaycees hereinafter specified, namely, the operation of carnival rides and a midway, including shows, riding devices and concessions not otherwise prohibited by law; all of which activities are to take place at the Civic Centre, north parking lot in conjunction with the Bramalea Jaycees.
2. The said activities specified in Paragraph 1 shall be limited to the period between one and six o'clock in the afternoon of Sunday, the 8th day of May, 1983, but nothing in this paragraph shall limit the time during which said club may conduct any aspect of its carnival which would not otherwise be unlawful under the Lord's Day Act (Canada).
3. All activities permitted by this by-law shall be conducted in an orderly manner.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 25th day of April 1983.
