

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 118-97
To approve the expropriation of certain lands in the City of Brampton being part of Lot 14, Concession 5
East of Hurontario Street

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of City of Brampton, as expropriating authority, on the 9th day of September, 1996, passed By-law 168-96 authorizing the expropriation of the part of Lot 14, Concession 6 East of Hurontario Street now designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 43R-21818, and further, authorizing the Clerk to sign notices and advertisements on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as required by the Expropriations Act;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has complied with the requirements of the Expropriations Act regarding service of notice of the application for approval to expropriate and the advertisement of said notice;

AND WHEREAS and the property owners have agreed to a reduced taking of land which will be sufficient to accommodate the proposed works;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The expropriation of the part of the West Half of Lot 14, Concession 6 East of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 43R-22177 is hereby approved by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
- 2. The lands described in section 1 to this by-law are hereby expropriated for the purposes of road widening and for the placing of an earth embankment to support an existing gabion wall.
- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to carry out this expropriation.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of May, 1997.
