BY-LAW

Number <u>118-2000</u>

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plans 43M-1377

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1.

Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act, does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 3 to 13 inclusive, 24 to 33 inclusive, 37 to 55 inclusive, 58 to 65 inclusive, 67 to 73 inclusive, 76 to 81 inclusive, 84 to 92 inclusive, 99 to 122 inclusive, 125 to 142 inclusive, 145, 148 to 150 inclusive and 153, on Registered Plan 43M-1377
