To make it lawful for any person  
to engage in or be present at  
certain activities on the Lord's Day


WHEREAS the Brampton Kinsmen Club proposes to hold part of  
its annual exhibition and show on Sunday, the 12th day of May, 1985;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of  
Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of the Lord's Day Ontario Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253,  
as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of  
Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by  
the Brampton Kinsmen Club at Bramalea City Centre, in the  
City of Brampton, and in respect of all activities provided  
in connection therewith, including the operation of a "midway"  
with shows, rides, games and concessions.
2. The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall  
be permitted after the hour of 12:00 noon on Sunday, the 12th  
day of May, 1985, but nothing in this section shall in any  
way limit the time during which the said Brampton Kinsmen  
Club may conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show  
which is not unlawful under the Lord's Day Act (Canada).
3. The Brampton Kinsmen Club shall conduct the activities  
hereby permitted in an orderly manner.
