# BY-LAW

**Number** 119-98

To authorize the sale of certain  
surplus parkland  
and to repeal By-law 89-98

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that the land described herein is no longer required for the purposes of the Municipality.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Part of Block 252, Plan 43M-1127, designated as Part 2 on a preliminary plan prepared by Schaeffer & Reinthaler Limited, Job No. 94209, is hereby declared surplus. The sale of the land at not less than \$5.74 per square foot, plus legal, survey and landscaping costs is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the transfer of the land described in this by-law.
3. By-law 89-98 is hereby repealed.
