

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 120-74

A By-law to provide for the making of a grant to the Peel Federation of Agriculture to assist in it's program of Warble Fly Control.


WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, Section 352, paragraph 33a, subparagraph (b), authorizes the Councils of all municipalities to pass by-laws for making grants to farm organizations or agricultural commodity groups;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to assist the Peel Federation of Agriculture in it's program of Warble Fly Control;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That a grant of up to Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) is hereby authorized to the Peel Federation of Agriculture to assist it in it's Warble Fly Control program.
2. That the said grant shall be payable on the basis of an allowance of Four Dollars (\$4.00) per hour and Fifteen (15¢) Cents per mile travelling allowance to the inspectors hired by the Peel Federation of Agriculture to carry out it's Warble Fly Control program and the said sum shall be paid by the City of Brampton out of the grant authorized by paragraph 1 hereof upon the submission by the Peel Federation of Agriculture of invoices for the time and mileage of it's inspectors spent carrying on it's Warble Fly Control program within the City of Brampton.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 7th day of October, 1974.
