To amend By-law 56-83, as amended,	
The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton	
ENACTS as follows:	
1. By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:	
(1) by changing on Sheet 13 of Schedule A thereto, th	
land use designation of the lands shown outlined	
on Schedule A to this by-law from INDUSTRIAL THRE	ŀΕ
- SECTION 561 (M3-SECTION 561) to INDUSTRIAL THRE	Œ
- SECTION 632 (M3-SECTION 632);	
(2) by adding thereto the following section:	
"632 The lands designated M3-Section 632 on	
Schedule A to this by-law:	

632.1

purposes:

(a) the manufacturing, cleaning, packaging, processing, repairing or assembly of goods, foods or materials within an enclosed building;

shall only be used for the following

(b) a motor vehicle repair shop and a motor

vehicle body shop as a principle or accessory use;

- (c) industrial uses involving the storage of goods and materials in the open;
- (d) a printing establishment;
- (e) a warehouse;
- (f) a parking lot;
- (g) the purposes permitted by section 33.1.1
 (b) and section 33.1.1 (c) of this by-law;
- (h) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes.
- shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - (1) No motor vehicle repair facility or body shop shall be located within 25 metres of the front lot line.
- shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the M3 zone and all other general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 632.2"

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 13th day of June 1994


