BY-LAW

Number 120-2010

To approve the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of facilitating the Bus Rapid Transit (Zum) project along Main Street/Hurontario Street corridor

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, at its meeting of August 5, 2009, enacted By-law 230-2009 to authorize the expropriation of certain lands and interest in land for the purpose of facilitating the Bus Rapid Transit (Zum) project along the Main Street/Hurontario Street corridor;

AND WHEREAS notice of Council's intention to expropriate the said lands were served on all persons with an interest in the lands and in accordance with the provisions of the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E26, as amended;

AND WHEREAS none of the persons with an interest in the lands as identified in Schedule "A" to this by-law have requested a Hearing of Necessity under the provisions of the Expropriations Act;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The expropriation of the lands in the City of Brampton described in Schedule "A" to this by-law for the purpose of facilitating the Bus Rapid Transit (Zum) project along the Main Street/Hurontario Street corridor is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and where appropriate to register on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as approving authority all notices, plans, certificates and other documents and forms required by the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E26, as amended, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, in order to complete the expropriation of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 28th day of April, 2010.
