BY-LAW

Number 123-82

To prevent the application of part lot control of certain plans of subdivision in the City of Brampton (Plans M-281 and M-282) (LAKEVIEW ESTATES)

WHEREAS subsection 29(5) of The Planning Act (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 379, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 29(10) of The Planning Act, the council of the municipality may by by-law provide that such part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 29 of The Planning Act does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A attached hereto.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of July, 1982.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 123-82

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel and being composed of:

FIRSTLY: the whole of Blocks BB, DD, GG and II, according to a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as number M-281, and

SECONDLY: the whole of Block J, according to a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as number M-282.
