To amend By-law 270-2004, as amended

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands as shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law:

From:	То:	
Agricultural (A)	Commercial One – Section 1421 (C1 – 1421)	

- (2) by adding thereto the following section:
 - "1421 The lands designated C1 1421 on Schedule A to this By-law:
 - 1421.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:
 - a) a retail establishment having no outside storage
 - b) a grocery store
 - c) a service shop
 - d) a personal service shop
 - e) a bank, trust company, or finance company
 - f) an office
 - g) a dry cleaning and laundry distribution station
 - h) a laundromat
 - i) a parking lot
 - j) a dining restaurant, a take-out restaurant
 - k) an animal hospital
 - I) a religious institution
 - m) a library
 - n) purposes accessory to other permitted purposes

PACE 2 TO BY LAW 125 2009

shall be subject to the following requirements and 1421.2 restrictions:

> Minimum Front Yard Depth: (a)

10 metres

Minimum Interior Side Yard Width:

9 metres

Minimum Exterior Side Yard Width: 3.2 metres

Minimum Rear Yard Depth:

3.2 metres

(e) Minimum distance to the Visibility Triangle:

2 metres

- Minimum Required Parking: 1 parking space for (f) each 22 square metres of commercial floor area, except for a religious institution which parking shall be provided in accordance with section 20.3.1 of this by-law
- Except for approved access locations, landscaped open space shall be provided as follows:
 - (1) a minimum 3.0 metre wide abutting Charolais Boulevard lot line;
 - a minimum 6.0 metre wide abutting Chinguacousy Road lot line
- (h) All garbage and refuse storage, including any containers for the storage of recyclable materials shall be enclosed and screened
- (i) All restaurant refuse storage shall be enclosed in a climate controlled area within the building
- All rooftop units shall be screened. (j)
- Outside storage of goods and materials shall not be (k) permitted."


