To amend By-law 139-84 (the
Mississauga comprehensive zoning
by-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting therefrom section 44.1.1, and substituting therefor the following:

"44.1.1 shall only be used for the following:

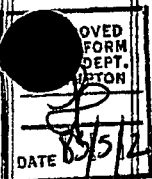
- (a) an indoor or outdoor recreation facility operated or licensed by, or leased from, or managed under an agreement with, a public authority, including a conservation authority;
- (b) any conservation area or purpose, and
- (c) purposes accessory to other permitted purposes."




DECLARATION
