# BY-LAW

Number 127-2004

A By-law to amend Licensing By-law 1-2002  
by amending Schedule M-2, relating to Owners,  
Operators and Drivers of Vehicles from which  
Refreshments are Sold for Consumption by  
the Public

The Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule M-2 of Licensing By-law 1-2002 is amended as follows:


(1) By adding to Schedule M-2, Section 7, the following:

(7.1) "Notwithstanding any other provision in this by-law, a licensed Class D refreshment vehicle may sell in a public park subject to the following:

- (a) that the licensee has entered into a signed agreement with the City of Brampton;
- (b) that the site specific location from which the vehicle is permitted to sell be approved by the Commissioner of Community Services and form part of the agreement with the City of Brampton; and
- (c) that the hours of operation form part of the agreement with the City of Brampton."


(7.2) "No person shall sell or offer for sale refreshments in contravention of the signed agreement with the City of Brampton."
