


A By-law to amend the Official Plan of the former Town of Mississauga Planning Area, now part of the City of Brampton Planning Area.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, in accordance with the provisions of The Planning Act, (R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 349, as amended) and the Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 1973, hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Amendment No. 266 to the Official Plan of the former Town of Mississauga Planning Area, now part of the City of Brampton Planning Area, consisting of the attached map and explanatory text, is hereby adopted.
2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to make application to the Minister of Housing, for approval of the aforementioned Amendment No. 266 to the Official Plan of the former Town of Mississauga Planning Area, now part of the City of Brampton Planning Area.
3. This By-law shall not come into force or take effect until approved by the Minister of Housing.
