To name a private right of way for purpose of the Emergency Municipal Numbering System

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has established an emergency municipal numbering system for properties abutting streets in the rural area of Brampton.

Paragraph 112 of section 210 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, as amended, permits Council to pass bylaws for numbering buildings and lots that it is considered necessary to number by the Council.

Section 102 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> permits Council to pass by-laws for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality in matters not specifically provided for by the <u>Municipal Act</u>.

It is necessary for purposes of the emergency municipal numbering system to assign a name to the private right of way.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The private right of way shown on the sketch attached as Schedule A hereto as "private road" is hereby named Gowland Road, for purposes of the emergency municipal numbering system.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of June, 1997.
