
A By-law to prohibit or regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height and location of buildings in part of the west half of Lot 7, Concession 4, East of Hurontario Street (Township of Chinguacousy) in the City of Brampton.


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton Enacts as follows:

1. That notwithstanding the requirements applying to an Agricultural Class One - A1 Zone as set out in By-law 861, as amended by By-law 877, the lands described in Schedule 'A' to this By-law shall be used for no other purpose than a Nursery School. Schedule 'A' designates the various facilities associated with the nursery school, and such designated areas can only be used for the purposes shown. The proposed play area 'to be built' shall be enclosed by a fence which type may be optional except for the south easterly limit of the said play area which shall have a size (6') foot solid screen wood fence.
2. Schedule 'A' to this By-law is part of this By-law.
3. This By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council

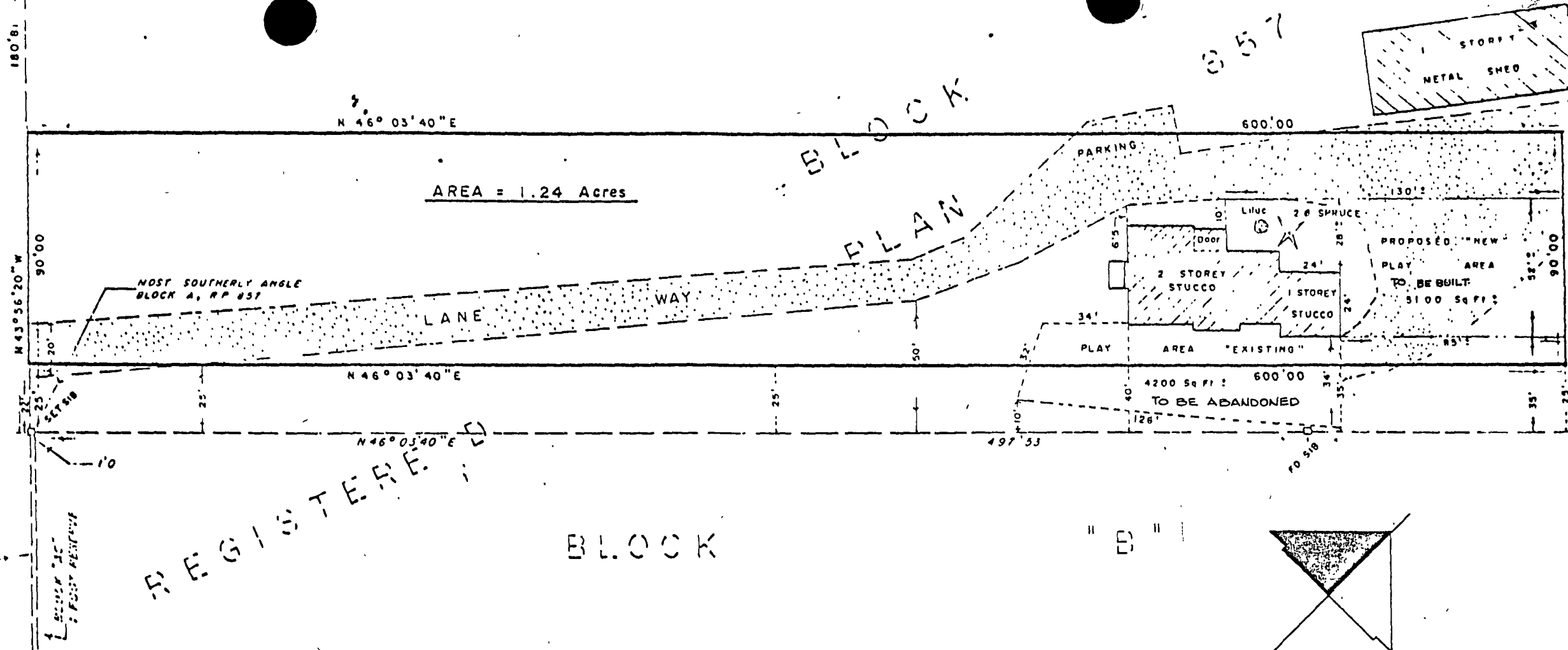
