its annual e	WHEREAS The Kinsmen Club of Bramalea, proposes to hold part of whibition and show on Sunday, the 19th day of June 1988
Brampton ENA	NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of CTS as follows:
1.	Section 6 of the Lord's Day Ontario Act (R.S.O. 1980, C.253, as ammended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by the Kinsmen Club of Bramalea, at the 410 and 7 Plaza in the City of Brampton and in respect of all activities of a "midway" with shows, rides games and concessions.
2.	The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall be permitted after the hour of 12:00 noon on Sunday, the 19th day of June 1988, but nothing in this section shall in any way limit the time during which the said Kinsmen Club of Bramalea may conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful under the Lord's Day Act (Canada).
3.	The Kinsmen Club of Bramalea shall conduct the activities hereby
