

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 133-75

Being a By-law to prevent the application of part lot control to certain plans of subdivision in the City of Brampton.


WHEREAS The Planning Amendment Act, 1970 has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS The Council of the municipality may by By-law provide that such part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans as are designated in the By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 4 of Section 29 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 349 as amended, does not apply to the lands within the registered plans described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. This By-law shall come into force upon approval of the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL this 21st day of July, 1975.
