WHEREAS Schedule A to By-law 263-80 indicates that 6 parking spaces are required for the development to which it applies;

AND WHEREAS an error was made in that section 3.2(e) of the said by-law requires only 5 parking spaces;


AND WHEREAS the City, at the hearing before the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the City's application for approval of By-law 263-80, undertook to correct the said error;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 3.2(e) of By-law 263-80 is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words, "five parking spaces", and substituting therefor the words, "six parking spaces".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of June, 1981.

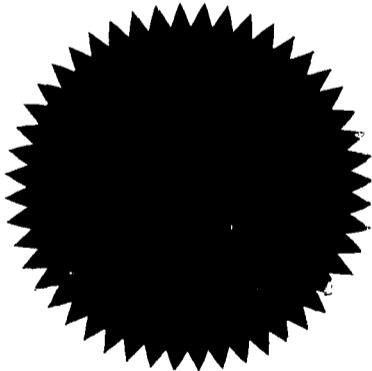
