

- 1. The transfer of a watermain easement to The Regional Municipality of Peel over the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law for consideration of \$2.00 is hereby authorized and the said easements rights are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a transfer of easement in a form approved by the City Solicitor together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the transfer of easement.
