WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has, by resolution, decided that all works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plans 43M-1666 and 43M-1667 be accepted and assumed;

AND WHEREAS Council has authorized the City Treasurer to retain \$37,000 in securities held by the City for outstanding warrantees in Open Space;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume the streets and street widening block on Registered Plan 43M-1666 and 43M-1667 as part of the public highway system.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby **ENACTS** as follows:

1. All of the works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plan 43M-1666 and 43M-1667 are hereby accepted and assumed.
2. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.
